

# Welcome to Y2!



Each week children will be set home learning in the following subjects:

## Reading

Children are encouraged to read at home every day. This should be recorded in the child's reading record and brought into school every **Friday** for checking. Every time a child reads at home they will receive a smile.

Children are encouraged to change their own books & can do this at break/lunch/after school. In addition, all children will be encouraged to complete the whole school reading challenge. The reading challenge consists of 30 reading based activities which children can complete over the course of the year. After the first 10 activities children will receive the bronze reading challenge award; after 20 the silver and after 30 the gold reading award.



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## Spellings

Spellings will be set each **Friday**, ready to be tested on the following **Friday**. Spellings will also be shared on ClassDojo each week.

## Maths

Each week Maths home learning will be sent home. This will be either related to our learning for that week, number bonds or times tables. This will be handed out on a **Friday** and be due in the following **Wednesday**.

## Learning Challenge

A learning challenge home learning will be sent home every **half term**. Children can pick from the grid which activity/ies they wish to complete. This should be brought in to school on the date specified on the sheet, ready to share with the class.

In addition to the weekly take home activities, all children have access to on-line learning programmes to allow them to continue their learning at home. These include:
